RESOLUTION NUMBER 365

AUTHORIZING HANCOCK COUNTY ENGINEER
TO CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE
FOR MAINTENANCE, REPAIR AND
RESURFACING OF VILLAGE ROADS

WHEREAS, the Village has certain streets and roadways, which require maintenance, repair and resurfacing from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Village would benefit from joining in the bid process and having the contracts for such work combined with the contracts for similar projects from other local governmental agencies; and,

WHEREAS, the Hancock County Engineer's office has the expertise, authority, and ability to properly advertise for bids, to obtain contracts for such projects, and to supervise and control the completion of said projects; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Van Buren has identified the need during the year 2006 to repair and resurface Walnut Street between Main Street and May Street at an approximate total cost of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars \$7,500.00.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT THE Hancock County Engineer is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the Village of Van Buren in advertising for bids, letting contracts, and combining the following roadway maintenance, repair or resurfacing project with those of other governmental agencies for the purpose of completing the repair and resurface of Walnut Street between Main Street and May Street in the Village of Van Buren, Ohio at an approximate total cost of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars \$7,500.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village of Van Buren shall be responsible for the cost of such contract attributable to such roads, streets or area located within the village up to the maximum sum of \$7,500.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary as it is necessary to have the project completed timely to coordinate with the schedule of the County Engineer in order to maximize cost efficiency of the improvements and for the immediate health, welfare, and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Van Buren, Ohio.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
