- Greg Ayers to seek bids to seal cracks on Main Street and other areas within the Village street infrastructure for 2009.
- Greg Ayers to seek bids for painting cross-walks and parking strips for 2009
- Ed May reported that the 2009 football team is planning to paint curbs for the 2009
- The Committee is planning to have the curbs painted after Phase 3 of the Market Street Project is completed
- The Committee asked Ed May to send an email to the City of Findlay requesting a repair sidewalk form so we can send to all Van Buren Residents to repair their damaged sidewalks.
- The Committee reported that Kershner's snow plowing contract was approved by Council
- The Committee reported that they will contract TJD concerning fall leaf pickup. Plans are to start leaf pickup sometime during the week of November 9.
- The Committee report that they will contact TJD and Kershner seeking bids for catch basin clean out. Plans are to start cleaning out the catch basin in December.
