

RESOLUTION NO. 379

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS NECESSARY FOR FUNDING FOR THE VAN BUREN VILLAGE SQUARE PAVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Van Buren, Ohio, has been advised that funding has been made available to certain communities through the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC), State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program for assorted capital improvement projects; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Van Buren plans to make certain capital improvements to the sidewalks, curbs and rights of way in the Village, which are described as the Van Buren Village Square Improvement Project; and,

WHEREAS, Council now desires to proceed with the improvements, recognizing that the cost of the improvement will be approximately \$128,700.00 and that this cost will be met by a grant from the OPWC, but subject to the Village incurring the cost of engineering and planning for the project in the approximate amount of \$19,000.00; and,

Be It Therefore RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds in the amount of \$128,700.00.

Be It Further RESOLVED that this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate health, welfare, and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Van Buren, Ohio as it is necessary to forward the application

for these funds on or before September 13, 2008 in order to complete the project in the construction season.

Be It Further RESOLVED that it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that result in formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
